How does LEC's residential energy rate compare to the national average?	<i>About 1/2 the national average</i>
How many meters does the cooperative serve?	<i>More than 6,100</i>
When was LEC organized?	<i>January 1948</i>
How many miles of line does LEC own and maintain?	<i>977 miles</i>
When is the annual membership meeting?	<i>March or April of each year</i>
Who supplies LEC's wholesale power?	<i>The Bonneville Power Administration (BPA)</i>
What energy sources does BPA use to supply power to LEC?	<i>85% hydro from dams on the Columbia River System, 10% nuclear, and 5% renewables</i>
What program does LEC offer that allows members to pay in advance of their electric usage?	<i>Flex Advantage program</i>
